On Tuesday, June 25 at 6 p.m., we are hosting a kickoff meeting with a strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats (SWOT) session and three public listening sessions on Wednesday, June 26th starting at 9:00 am at the Farr Center, located at 5283 Main Street in Onekama, Michigan.

- June 25, 6 p.m.: Master Plan kickoff meeting and SWOT analysis
- June 26, 9 a.m.: Listening session No. 1
- June 26, 11:30 a.m.: Listening session No. 2
- June 26, 2 p.m.: Listening session No. 3

Topics included in the listening sessions and SWOT analysis include the following:

- Land Use: Balancing residential, commercial, and recreational spaces.
- Infrastructure: Enhancing roads, utilities, and public services.
- Environmental Stewardship: Protecting natural resources and promoting sustainability.
- Economic Development: Supporting and growing local businesses, attracting new investments, job creation.

Feedback from the public engagement sessions will be incorporated into the master plan update. Your engagement matters, and together, we can craft a vision for our vibrant and resilient community. Hope to see you on the 25th and 26th.
